The programme culminates with students creating their own professional-standard jewellery portfolio at the end of the final year.

Graduates of the course leave the British Academy of Jewellery as highly skilled technical makers and independent thinkers with a portfolio of jewellery creations that will allow them to enter the jewellery sector or start their own brands.
